DECISION

Background

- 1 This decision relates to the issue of whether the application, GB2610710 B should be revoked under Section 73(1) of the Patents Act.
- 2 In my decision BL 0/0018/26 issued on 14th January 2026, I found that Claim 1 of the application was anticipated by prior art, EP4316358. In doing so, I gave the applicant a further 28 days to submit amendments to overcome the citation of EP 4316358.
