DECISION

Curearth Inc, the patent proprietor has filed an application in accordance with Section 13(3) of the Patents Act 1977 to the effect that Hyung Joon Cha should not have been mentioned as a joint inventor.

The patent proprietor Curearth Inc and named joint inventors Hoon Cho, Sun Jong Yu and Seung Ho Baek have filed written consent in support of the application. Hyung Joon Cha has also confirmed in writing that they ought not to have been mentioned as a joint inventor of the patent. As such the application is treated as uncontested.

Accordingly, I find that Hyung Joon Cha should not have been mentioned as a joint inventor in the granted patent for the invention. This decision issued in accordance with Section 13(3) serves as a certificate to this effect. I therefore direct that an addendum slip be prepared for the granted patent stating that Hyung Joon Cha should not have been mentioned as a joint inventor.
