DECISION

- 1 Coldharbour Marine Limited the patent proprietor, has filed an application in accordance with rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Professor Peter James Dobson should have been mentioned as a joint inventor in patents GB2548418 and GB2521258.
- 2 Mark Wells and Andrew Marshall the existing named inventors have filed written consent in support of the application. Professor Peter James Dobson has also consented to being mentioned as a joint inventor. As such the application is treated as uncontested. I therefore conclude that Professor Peter James Dobson should be named as a joint inventor along with Mark Wells and Andrew Marshall.
- 3 Accordingly I find that Professor Peter James Dobson should be mentioned as a joint inventor in published patent application GB2548418 and in published patent application and granted patent GB2521258. I therefore direct, in accordance with rule 10(1), that an addendum slip be prepared for patents GB2548418 and GB2521258 accordingly.
