### DECISION

- 1 Servelec Technologies Limited the patent proprietor, has filed an application in accordance with rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Mark Howe and Tom Laxton should have been mentioned as joint inventors.
- 2 Michael Crowther the currently named inventor has filed written consent in support of the application. Mark Howe and Tom Laxton have also consented to being mentioned as joint inventors. As such the application is treated as uncontested. I therefore conclude that Mark Howe and Tom Laxton should be named as joint inventors along with Michael Crowther.
- 3 Accordingly I find that Mark Howe and Tom Laxton should be mentioned as joint inventors in the published patent application and the granted patent for the invention. I therefore direct, in accordance with rule 10(1), that an addendum slip be prepared to reflect this for the published patent application and the granted patent for the invention.
