DECISION

- 1 Jone Shou Industrial Co., Ltd., and Evolution Horseware Limited, the patent proprietors filed an application in accordance with rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Michael Loveridge should be mentioned as a joint inventor.
- 2 Jone Shou Industrial Co., Ltd., Evolution Horseware Limited, Chih-Shun Chang and Michael Loveridge have filed written consent in support of the application. As such the application is treated as unopposed. I therefore conclude that Michael Loveridge should be named as a joint inventor, along with Chih-Shun Chang.
- 3 Accordingly, I find that Michael Loveridge should be mentioned as a joint inventor in the published patent application and granted patent for the invention. I therefore direct, in accordance with rule 10(1), that an addendum slip mentioning Michael Loveridge as a joint inventor be prepared for the published patent and granted patent for the invention.
