DECISION

- 1 Fisher-Rosemount Systems, Inc., the patent proprietor filed an application in accordance with rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Godfrey R. Sherriff should be mentioned as a joint inventor of the above patent.
- 2 Fisher-Rosemount Systems, Inc. the patent proprietor, William G. Irwin and David L. Deitz the existing named inventors, have filed written consent in support of the application. Godfrey R. Sherriff has also consented to being mentioned as a joint inventor. As such the application is treated as uncontested. I therefore conclude that Godfrey R. Sherriff should be named as a joint inventor, along with William G. Irwin and David L. Deitz.
- 3 Accordingly I find that Godfrey R. Sherriff should be mentioned as a joint inventor in the published patent application and granted patent for the invention. I therefore direct, in accordance with rule 10(1), that an addendum slip be prepared to reflect this for the published patent application and granted patent accordingly.
