### DECISION

- 1 Patents Form 7 names one inventor: Christian Schon.
- 2 IB LAB GMBH the patent proprietor, has filed an application under rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Davul Ljuhar and Richard Ljuhar should have been mentioned as joint inventors in the patent and an application under section 13(3) to the effect that Christian Schon should not have been mentioned as inventor. IB LAB GMBH have filed a statement of grounds together with written consents from all parties to initiate these proceedings.
- 3 Christian Schon the currently named inventor has provided written consent to the application and has confirmed that Davul Ljuhar and Richard Ljuhar should have been named as joint inventors and that he should not have been mentioned as inventor in the patent application. Davul Ljuhar and Richard Ljuhar have confirmed in writing that they consent to being mentioned as joint inventors in the patent.
- 4 As such the application is treated as uncontested. I therefore conclude that Davul Ljuhar and Richard Ljuhar should have been mentioned as joint inventors of patent number GB2535379 and that Christian Schon should be removed from the list of inventors.
- 5 This decision serves as a certificate, issued in accordance with section 13(3), to the effect that Christian Schon should not have been mentioned as inventor in the published patent application.

6 I also direct that an addendum slip be prepared for the published patent application for the invention accordingly.
