

SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION

O/0112/26

Background

1. It has been drawn to my attention that my decision BL O/0942/25 dated 6 October 2025 contained typographical errors in paragraphs 53 and 54 which reads:

“53. Both parties have enjoyed a share of success, with the greater degree of success on the part of the applicant who is therefore entitled to a contribution towards its costs based upon the scale published in Tribunal Practice Notice (“TPN”) 1/2023. I have made a reduction to the costs to reflect the partial extent of the success. Applying the guidance in the TPN, I consider the following to be fair:

Preparing a counterstatement and considering the statement of grounds £250
Preparing and writing submissions in lieu of a hearing £350
Considering evidence and commenting on the other side’s evidence £400
Total: £1000

54. I therefore order Promovec Group A/S. to pay Viridi Parente, Inc. the sum of £1000. The above sum should be paid within twenty-one days of the expiry of the appeal period or, if there is an appeal, within twenty-one days of the conclusion of the appeal proceedings.

2. The greater degree of success and award of costs should have been attributed to the opponent rather than the applicant. These have been amended below accordingly, as a result, the paragraphs should read as follows:

“53. Both parties have enjoyed a share of success, with the greater degree of success on the part of the opponent who is therefore entitled to a contribution towards its costs based upon the scale published in Tribunal Practice Notice (“TPN”) 1/2023. I have made a reduction to the costs to reflect the partial extent of the success. Applying the guidance in the TPN, I consider the following to be fair:

Preparing a statement of grounds/ considering the counterstatement £250
Preparing and writing submissions in lieu of a hearing £350
Preparing evidence £400
Official Fees £100
Total: £1100

54. I therefore order Viridi Parente, Inc. to pay Promovec Group A/S. the sum of £1100. The above sum should be paid within twenty-one days of the expiry of the appeal period or, if there is an appeal, within twenty-one days of the conclusion of the appeal proceedings.

3. These errors are plainly an irregularity in procedure and are capable of being corrected under Rule 74 of the Trade Marks Rules 2008. Consequently, I give the parties notice that the above sections of the decision will be amended as stated above and apply as though they appeared in the original version of the decision. The appeal period, in respect of the costs only, is reset as a result of this supplemental decision.
