1. On 28 May 2026, I issued a decision in the above referenced proceedings. It has been brought to my attention that my decision contained a typographical error at paragraph 71. This stated that the outcome of the proceedings was that UKTM No. 4019168 would be declared invalid. However, the trade mark that was the subject of the application for invalidation was in fact No. 3449047.

2. I regard this as an irregularity in procedure that is capable of being corrected under Rule 74(1) of the Trade Marks Rules 2008.

3. This supplementary decision merely corrects that typographical error and paragraph 71 is hereby corrected to read:

“71. Subject to a successful appeal, UKTM No. 3449047 is declared invalid. Provided that this shall not affect past and closed transactions, the registration is deemed never to have been made.”

4. The above correction does not affect the appeal period, nor is there any impact on costs.
