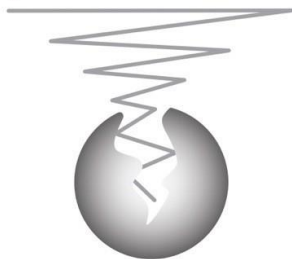

The goods and services registered under all of these marks are found within the Annex of this decision.

2. The trade marks were originally applied for and registered in the name of Pierre Cardin. On 22 February 2023, London IP Ltd filed a Form TM16 to record a change of ownership for each of the marks to Rodrigo Basilicati Cardin (“the proprietor”). The Form TM16 gave the method of transfer as “Assent of personal representative”, which is the transfer of property from the estate of the deceased by an executor or personal representative to a beneficiary of that estate and gave the “Date of transfer of ownership” as 29 December 2020.
3. On 3 April 2024, Sipara Ltd filed an application to rectify the register (Form TM26R) on behalf of the estate of Pierre Cardin (“the applicant”) claiming that the register should be rectified in accordance with section 64 of the Trade Marks Act (“the Act”).
4. In support of the application the witness statement of Katy Jane Fuggle of Sipara Ltd was submitted, which refers to a translation of the Court of Appeal judgement in relation to the estate of Pierre Cardin and its rightful heir and a signed affidavit from an official notary, Maître Henry Letulle. The pertinent points from the evidence are as follows:
  - Following the death of Mr Pietro Costante Cardin, known as Pierre Cardin, fashion designer, on 29 December 2020, the Presiding Judge of the Paris Judicial Court handed down a judgement on 6 January 2023 placing Mr Rodrigo Basilicati-Cardin in possession of the universal gift of the estate of Mr Pierre Cardin.
  - However, that was retracted in a judgement by the summary judge of the Paris Judicial Court on 29 March 2023.

- That retraction was upheld in a judgement from the Paris Court of Appeal on 25 January 2024.
  - The Court of Appeal judgement is automatically enforceable despite an appeal against it which was lodged with the Supreme Court of Appeal, and despite the three legal actions on the merits of the case which are currently pending before the Paris Judicial Court.
  - Whilst a final and binding judgement on the merits of the case settling the succession has not been handed down, the trademarks must be registered in the name of Pierre Cardin, the previous holder, instead of Mr Rodrigo Basilicati-Cardin.
5. Given that the applications for rectification were made by a person other than the registered proprietor, it was necessary to serve the applications on the proprietor in accordance with rule 44(2) of the Trade Marks Rules 2008. Accordingly, on 19 August 2024, the Registry served the Form TM26R's on the proprietor, setting a deadline of 21 October 2024 to file counterstatements and evidence or submissions. The proprietor did not file any counterstatements in respect of the above registrations.
6. On 13 November 2024, an official letter was issued stating that no counterstatements had been received by the above deadline and therefore it was the Registry's preliminary view to treat the rectifications as undefended.

## **DECISION**

7. The power to rectify the register is set out in section 64 of the Act:

“(1) Any person having a sufficient interest may apply for the rectification of an error or omission in the register: Provided that an application for rectification may not be made in respect of a matter affecting the validity of the registration of a trade mark.

(2) An application for rectification may be made either to the registrar or to the court, except that

(a) if proceedings concerning the trade mark in question are pending in the court, the application must be made to the court; and

(b) if in any other case the application is made to the registrar, he may at any stage of the proceedings refer the application to the court.

(3) Except where the registrar or the court directs otherwise, the effect of rectification of the register is that the error or omission in question shall be deemed never to have been made.

(4) The registrar may, on request made in the prescribed manner by the proprietor of a registered trade mark, or a licensee, enter any change in his name or address as recorded in the register.

(5) The registrar may remove from the register matter appearing to him to have ceased to have effect.”

8. That section of the Act must be interpreted and applied with reference to Section 63, which provides as follows:

“(1) The Register shall maintain a register of trade marks:

References in this Act to “the register” are to that register; and references to registration (in particular, in the expression “registered trade mark”) are, unless the context otherwise requires, to registration in that register.

(2) There shall be entered in the register in accordance with this Act –

(a) registered trade marks,

(b) such particulars as may be prescribed of registrable transactions affecting a registered trade mark, and

(c) such other matters relating to registered trade marks as may be prescribed.

(3) The register shall be kept in such manner as may be prescribed, and provision shall in particular be made for –

(a) public inspection of the register, and

(b) the supply of certified or uncertified copies, or extracts, of entries in the register.”

#### Sufficient interest

9. The applicant must have a sufficient interest to apply for rectification. The applicant was the original proprietor prior to the transfer of ownership upon his death. I therefore accept that the applicant’s estate has sufficient interest.

#### Is it an error capable of correction?

10. The reference in section 64(1) to errors or omissions in the register is to be interpreted more broadly than correcting simple clerical errors and can extend to questions of ownership.

11. This approach of rectifying errors or omissions over and above those that are clerical in nature has been adopted and maintained in a number of Tribunal decisions.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> In the Bendy Toys Limited case (BL O-336-01), paras 17-22, the Hearing Officer analysed the question of jurisdiction in the context of section 64(1) and found it should be broadly interpreted, particularly in cases where there is no other means of redress (such as via section 46 or section 47 of the Act). The Tribunal continued to take the approach of correcting errors or omissions over and above clerical mistakes in subsequent cases, for example BL O/283/02, BL O/284/02, BL O/040/05 and BL O/408/11.

12. There are questions in this case as to the validity of the transfer of ownership following the death of the original owner. It has been raised that there is an ongoing dispute in the French courts as to the rightful heir of the previous owner's (the applicant's) estate and it is contested that the transfer of ownership was based on a will that may not be valid under French law. As such, the matter at hand is not simply a question of pure clerical error, but I am content that the errors in question would be capable of correction through the rectification process if, upon review of the evidence, I were to accept the rectification applicant's position.
13. The applicant's position is that the matter as to the rightful heir of Mr Cardin's estate is still an unanswered question. That the trade marks were transferred into the proprietor's name in error, prior to a dispute arising. As a means of correcting this error the applicant highlights that the French courts have directed that the trade marks subject to these rectification proceedings should be placed back into Mr Cardin's name until such time that the matter is resolved.
14. Having considered the documents provided as supporting evidence that are referred to above at paragraph 4, I am prepared to accept that the trade marks should be placed back into Mr Cardin's estate until such time that the French courts have made a final ruling as to the proper heir to his estate.
15. In view of the foregoing, I am prepared to accept that the register does stand in error and that it is right that the error be corrected, particularly as I acknowledge that the proprietor does not appear to challenge this position.

## **CONCLUSION**

16. The applications for rectification have succeeded.
17. The register will be rectified to record Mr Pierre Cardin (the estate of) as the proprietor for the trade marks as set out in paragraph 1 of this decision as directed by the French Courts and that was the position prior to the matter of disputed wills and inheritance arising.

## **COSTS**

18.No request for costs has been made and I make no order in this regard.
