## BACKGROUND

1. These proceedings concern an application by YETI Coolers, LLC to revoke trade mark registration number UK00911141637 in the name of YETIGEL INTERNATIONAL (S.A) (“YETIGEL”). The trade mark is for the word YETI. It was applied for on 25 August 2012 and has a registration date of 5 August 2016, with a priority date of 26 February 2012. The mark stands registered for goods and services in Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44 and 45. See Annex 1 for the full list of YETIGEL’s goods and services.
2. The application to revoke the trade mark (Form TM26(N)) was made on 3 November 2021. The application for revocation was based on sections 46(1)(a) and 46(1)(b) of the Trade Marks Act 1994 (“the Act”) and was directed against all of the goods and services in the registration.
3. On 8 November 2021, the tribunal wrote to YETIGEL at its address for service in France, serving the Form TM26(N). The tribunal used the Royal Mail “International Tracked and Signed” service. An extract of the accompanying letter is copied below, with the original emphasis:

“Rule 38(3) of the Trade Marks Rules 2008 require that you must file your notice of defence and counterstatement (Form TM8(N)) within **two months** from the date of this letter.

**IMPORTANT DEADLINE: A completed Form TM8(N) MUST be received on or before 10 January 2022.**”

4. The letter also asked YETIGEL to provide a UK address for service. The tribunal sent a second letter on 8 November 2021, by ordinary post, retracting this request and confirming that YETIGEL could continue to use its French address.

5. The tracking information on the Royal Mail website shows the first letter that the tribunal sent on 8 November 2021, the one which served the Form TM26(N), going through various stages, including being “Despatched to Heathrow Worldwide DC” from “Cardiff MC” at 21:08 on Monday 8 November 2021. At 14:55 on Saturday 13 November 2021, the item of mail is described as having “left the overseas International Processing Centre” at “ROSSY PIAC EXPORT, France”. The letter is shown as “delivered” at 11:03 on Monday 15 November 2021 in “Avignon, France”.
6. The information on the Royal Mail website is corroborated by the information on the La Poste website, La Poste being Royal Mail’s delivery partner for this item of mail. On Monday 15 November, there are two “STEPS” shown: A green tick with “Your item has arrived at its delivery hub. We are preparing its delivery,” and then a green tick with “Your item has been delivered.”
7. On 27 January 2022, the tribunal wrote to YETIGEL, saying that, having not received YETIGEL’s Form TM8(N) and counterstatement, it was the preliminary view of the tribunal that YETIGEL be treated as not opposing the application for revocation and that therefore the registration should be revoked. This is because no defence had been filed within the prescribed period. If YETIGEL disagreed with this preliminary view, it was required to provide full written reasons and a Witness Statement explaining why the Form TM8(N) and counterstatement were being filed outside of the prescribed period. The tribunal sent a second letter on the same date which corrected the original deadline for responding to its letter. The corrected deadline was 27 February 2022.
8. On 28 February 2022 (that being the first working day after the deadline), YETIGEL, through Boulton Wade Tennant LLP, the legal representatives which it had now appointed, sent the following documents to the tribunal:

- “1. Letter on behalf of the trade mark proprietor concerning:

- a. Response to the Tribunal's preliminary view of 27 January 2022 and request for a hearing
  - b. Filing of a TM8(N) and preliminary evidence of use
  - c. Filing of a TM9R and request for retrospective extension of time
2. Form TM8(N)
  3. Form TM9R
  4. Witness Statement of Diane Grau dated 27 January 2022 concerning the non-receipt of official letters issued by the IPO in connection with these proceedings.
  5. Witness Statement of Ai Ling Lim-Lee dated 17 February 2022 and Exhibits ALL1-ALL6 concerning postal service disruption.
  6. Witness Statement of Didier Chehovah dated 28 February 2022 and Exhibits DC1-DC26 containing preliminary evidence of genuine use of the trade mark subject of these proceedings."

It also sent in an addendum to the Form TM8(N) on the same date.

9. In the witness statement from Ai Ling Lim-Lee, trade mark attorney for Boulton Wade Tennant, it is stated:

"On behalf of our client we filed UK Opposition No. OP000429359 against Yeti Coolers LLC's Trade Mark App No. 3662572 YETI. In connection with this opposition, I was first notified on 19 January 2022 by the UKIPO of its two letters dated 8 November 2021, addressed to our client in Avignon, France. These letters refer to a cancellation action filed earlier by Yeti Coolers LLC against our client's UK TM Registration No. 911141637 YETI (upon which our client's Opp000429359 is based). I noted then that the deadline of 10

January 2022 for our client to file its TM8N and counter-statement against YETI Coolers LLC had expired.

On 26 January 2022, I understood from our client that they had not received either of the 8 November 2021 UKIPO letters. I believe this to be entirely understandable, given the severe delays and disruption to the postal service from the final quarter of 2021, mainly caused by the onset of the Omicron virus within Europe and worldwide.”

Ai Ling Lim-Lee’s witness statement then references the six exhibits, ALL1-ALL6, which comprise a service update from Parcelforce and press reports regarding postal delays.

10. The witness statement from Diane Grau, the legal director of YETIGEL, says the following:

“On the 24 January 2022, @Mark [YETIGEL’s French lawyers] made me aware that a cancellation action CA000504312 had be [sic] filed by Yeti Coolers, LLC against UK TM Registration No. 911141637 YETI of my Company. Up until then, I had no knowledge of the cancellation action. @Mark have informed me that the UKIPO sent to my company two letters dated 8 November 2021. However, I have never received these letters from the UKIPO and I have only become aware of them when they have been forwarded to me by @Mark.”

11. YETIGEL’s case was that it did not receive the letter sent by the tribunal which served the Form TM26(N) and that was why it did not respond by the deadline of 10 January 2022. It considered there to have been a failure of a communication service which, in accordance with rule 76(1) of the Trade Mark Rules 2008 (“the Rules”) would allow the registrar to extend the deadline.

12. On 7 March 2022, the tribunal wrote to YETIGEL. An extract from the letter is below:

“After careful consideration of the contents of the papers you have provided, it is the preliminary view of the Registrar that the reasons given are not sufficient to exercise his limited discretion and admit a late filed Form TM8(N) into these proceedings. Given that the Royal Mail Track and Trace service confirms that the official letter (and TM26N) dated 8 November 2021 was delivered at the Registered Proprietor’s recorded address on 15 November 2021 the Registrar can’t see any grounds that would allow the admittance of the late filed TM8(N) form.

Therefore, the Registrar’s preliminary view is that this registration is to be declared revoked.”

13. YETIGEL was given until 21 March 2022 to object to the tribunal’s preliminary view and request an oral hearing.

14. On 21 March 2022, YETIGEL wrote a letter to the tribunal objecting to the preliminary view and requested an oral hearing. The letter was accompanied by a second witness statement from Diane Grau along with Exhibits DG1, DG2, and DG4, there being no Exhibit DG3.

15. Subsequently, French to English translations of Exhibits DG1 and DG4, referenced as DG1T and DG4T, were provided.

16. Diane Grau’s second witness statement acknowledges the tribunal’s letter and the “Track and Trace” information confirming delivery of the letter with the Form TM26(N) on 15 November. Diane Grau made enquiries of La Poste and Exhibit DG1 is “an email from La Poste, which suggests that the 8 November 2021 letter was delivered to my Company at 12.03 on the 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and signed for.”

17. Diane Grau goes on to say that only an authorized signatory – usually Mr Didier Chehovah – should have signed for such a document. Neither Mr Chehovah, Diane Grau or any of her colleagues recognized the signature.

18. Diane Grau continues:

“I have checked with the customer service department of La Poste and they gave me contradictory information, sometimes informing me that the letter was returned to the sender, sometimes that it was delivered on the 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

I therefore submitted a claim to the customer service of La Poste in order to find the letter, but I was informed that only the sender of the letter, i.e. its owner, could submit a claim to request an investigation. This information was confirmed by the “international mail” department of the post office (exhibit DG4).”

19. Diane Grau also references issues with deliveries from La Poste along with Exhibit DG2 which is an article from [connexionfrance.com](http://connexionfrance.com).

## **THE JOINT HEARING**

20. The Joint Hearing took place before me, via Microsoft Teams, on 7 April 2022. Tony Pluckrose and Catherine Wolfe, from Boulton Wade Tennant LLP, attended on behalf of YETIGEL. YETI Coolers, LLC did not attend, but filed written submissions in lieu via its legal representatives, Dehns.

## **THE ARGUMENTS PUT FORWARD**

21. YETIGEL’s skeleton arguments ran to eight pages, along with eleven annexes. While I have taken into account all of the submissions made, I do not consider it necessary to reproduce them here.

22. Mr Pluckrose went through his client's skeleton arguments in detail, placing particular emphasis on the claim that no one at YETIGEL recognized the signature on the La Poste receipt that was produced in evidence as Exhibit DG1. His argument is that this "illegible" signature is the only information on the receipt relating to an individual, there being no individual name or title on it.
23. Mr Pluckrose also contends that YETIGEL made extensive enquiries within the company regarding the two letters that were sent on 8 November to its French address and says they were not found. He also highlighted La Poste's "inconsistent" replies to YETIGEL's enquiries.
24. Taking what Mr Pluckrose considers to be the limited information from La Poste, together with the prevalence of the Omicron variant and the difficulties it caused within the postal service during the relevant period, I am being asked to conclude that, on the balance of probabilities, the letter serving the Form TM26(N) was not delivered to YETIGEL. On that basis, I am being asked to invoke rule 76 and decide that there was a failure of a communication service and therefore I must extend the deadline for sending in the Form TM8(N).
25. YETIGEL's legal representatives consider the proper basis for their client's objection to the tribunal's preliminary view, that the late Form TM8(N) not be admitted, is rule 76. However, they also went on to consider the wider basis on which the late Form TM8(N) might be admitted under rule 38(6) and set out their arguments accordingly.
26. The cancellation applicant, in its written submissions, contends that one would not typically expect the track and trace service to require a name or title when obtaining a signature.
27. The cancellation applicant notes that none of YETIGEL's employees has admitted to recognizing the signature. It presumes that the relevant

employee is unlikely to be keen to identify themselves as being at fault. It goes on to say: “We also note that signatures for delivery of post are often provided in a rushed manner and/or in circumstances which make it difficult to accurately reproduce one’s signature, in particular when one is asked to sign onto a digital screen.”

28. The cancellation applicant argues that “The Registrant’s failure to file a defence is clearly due to an internal mistake, oversight, ineffectiveness or failure in the processing of its own mail for which no leniency should be permitted.”

## **DECISION**

### **Statutory provisions**

29. Rule 76 of the Rules is set out below. It applies over and above the specific rules that apply to Form TM8(N).

#### **“Delays in communication services**

76.—(1) The registrar shall extend any time limit in these Rules where the registrar is satisfied that the failure to do something under these Rules was wholly or mainly attributed to a delay in, or failure of, a communication service.

(2) Any extension under paragraph (1) shall be—

(a) made after giving the parties such notice; and

(b) subject to such conditions,

as the registrar may direct.

(3) In this rule “communication service” means a service by which documents may be sent and delivered and includes post, facsimile, email and courier.”

30. The period allowed for the filing of Form TM8(N), as per rule 38(3), is a non-extensible one governed by Schedule 1 of the Rules. Other than where rule 77(5) is invoked because there is found to have been an irregularity on the part of the tribunal, the only basis on which the registrar may allow a proprietor to file a Form TM8(N) after the due date is if he is satisfied that it is appropriate to exercise his discretion as contained in rule 38(6) which reads as follows:

“38(6) Where the proprietor fails to file a Form TM8(N) within the period specified under paragraph (3) the registration of the mark shall, unless the registrar directs otherwise, be revoked.”

### **My findings**

31. I first look at the case in respect of rule 76.

32. In sending the letter which served the Form TM26(N), the tribunal used the Royal Mail “International Tracked and Signed” service. I reiterate that the tracking information on the Royal Mail website shows the first letter that the tribunal sent on 8 November 2021, the one which served the Form TM26(N), going through various stages and being “delivered” at 11:03 on Monday 15 November 2021 in “Avignon, France”. This is corroborated by the information on the La Poste website, indicating the item was delivered on Monday 15 November.

33. The tracking information on the respective websites is in fact entirely consistent with the La Poste receipt which YETIGEL has supplied in the evidence as Exhibit DG1. The reference number on the receipt is identical to that shown on the tracking information on the respective websites. The “address of the sender” shown on the receipt is the official address of the tribunal. The “address of the recipient” shown on the receipt corresponds exactly to the company name and address used in the tribunal’s letter which

served the Form TM26(N). the “date and time of signature” is 15/11/2021 at 12:03, precisely the date and time shown on the Royal Mail website (allowing for France being one hour ahead of the UK).

34. Set against what I consider to be the above compelling evidence, YETIGEL says that it has not been able to identify the signature of the person that signed for the letter and that it has not been able to find the letter at its company address. It states that it has been given contradictory information by La Poste customer services, and that there were problems with La Poste’s deliveries during the relevant period caused by the Omicron outbreak.
35. While I accept that Diane Grau likely only became aware of the letter serving the Form TM26(N) on 24 January 2022, having been contacted by YETIGEL’s French lawyers, the overwhelming weight of the evidence points to the letter having been successfully delivered to YETIGEL’s address for service. While Diane Grau attests that La Poste customer service gave YETIGEL contradictory responses regarding the item of mail in question, I have not been provided with a full chain of correspondence in that regard.
36. Regarding the evidence indicating that there were general problems with the postal service during the relevant period caused by the Omicron outbreak, in this specific instance the evidence indicates that no such problems occurred. There is a clear, documented basis for concluding that the item of mail in question was successfully delivered at 12:03 on 15 November 2021 and that therefore the tribunal correctly discharged its responsibilities in serving the Form TM26(N) on YETIGEL.
37. It is apparent that the letter was not passed to Diane Grau. The fact that the letter was not passed to the appropriate person or people within the company is no fault of the tribunal or the relevant postal services. There has been no failure of a communication service and I therefore reject the request to admit the late Form TM8(N) on the basis of rule 76.

38. I have found that rule 76 does not apply. By the same token, there has been no irregularity on the part of the tribunal. While the tribunal did make two errors in the course of writing to YETIGEL, it swiftly corrected both of them, and they are not material to the fundamental question of whether the letter serving the Form TM26(N) was received by YETIGEL. As such, rule 77(5) is not invoked. Consequently, the only basis on which the late Form TM8(N) may be admitted is if I exercise the discretion afforded to me by the use of the words “unless the registrar otherwise directs” in rule 38(6).

39. In approaching the exercise of discretion in these circumstances, I take into account the decisions of the Appointed Person in *Kickz AG v Wicked Vision Limited* (BL O-035-11) and *Mark James Holland v Mercury Wealth Management Limited* (BL O-050-12) i.e. I have to be satisfied that there are extenuating circumstances which justify the exercise of the discretion in YETIGEL’s favour.

40. In *Music Choice Ltd’s Trade Mark* [2005] RPC 18, the Court indicated that a consideration of the following factors (underlined below) is likely to be of assistance in reaching a conclusion as to whether or not discretion should be exercised in favour of a party in default. That is the approach I intend to adopt, referring to the parties’ submissions to the extent that I consider it necessary to do so.

The circumstances relating to the missing of the deadline including reasons why it was missed and the extent to which it was missed

41. I have found that the letter serving the Form TM26(N) was received at YETIGEL’S address for service on 15 November 2021. The deadline for filing Form TM8(N) and a counterstatement was 10 January 2021.

42. The deadline was missed because the letter was not passed to the appropriate people within the company to act upon it. Diane Grau, YETIGEL’s legal director, became aware of the letter on 24 January 2022, having been contacted by YETIGEL’s French lawyers.

43. On 27 January 2022, the tribunal wrote to YETIGEL, saying that it had not received YETIGEL's Form TM8(N) and counterstatement and that it was the preliminary view of the tribunal that YETIGEL be treated as not opposing the application for revocation and that therefore the registration should be revoked.

44. The deadline for responding to this letter was 27 February 2022.

YETIGEL responded to the letter on 28 February 2022 (the first working day after the deadline) and its Form TM8(N) was one of the papers sent in at that point.

The nature of the cancellation applicant's allegations in its statement of grounds

45. The application for revocation is based on sections 46(1)(a) and 46(1)(b) of the Act and is properly made out.

The consequences of treating the registered proprietor as defending or not defending the cancellation application

46. If YETIGEL is allowed to defend the cancellation application, the proceedings will continue and the matter will be determined on its merits.

47. If YETIGEL is not allowed to defend the cancellation application, it will lose its registration from the earliest date of revocation sought i.e. 6 August 2021.

Any prejudice caused to the cancellation applicant by the delay

48. The cancellation applicant submits that it has been put to additional expense as a result of the attempt to late-file the Form TM8(N). In terms of the timetable, YETIGEL contends that, had it filed its Form TM8(N) on time, it would have had until 10 March 2022 to file its evidence of use, whereas it has already filed its evidence of use as at 28 February 2022.

Any other relevant considerations such as the existence of related proceedings between the parties

49. As per YETIGEL's skeleton arguments, the loss of its registration would mean that it would be unable to:

“assert it in oppositions to later filed UKTM applications of the Applicant for the identical mark YETI, e.g., the application 3730072 filed on the 7 December 2021 and the applications 3735777 and 3735842 filed on the 22 December 2021 and the application 3763738 filed on the 9 March 2022, as well as the application 3746095 YETI CONCHO filed on the 21 January 2022 and the application 3748632 YETI THIN ICE filed on the 28 January 2022.”

And, further:

“There are also related proceedings at the IPO, including the Opposition [Opposition No. OP000429359] and also Opposition No. OP000430890 of the Proprietor to UKTM application 3695356 of the Applicant.”

50. I have to be satisfied that there are extenuating circumstances which justify the exercise of discretion in YETIGEL's favour. Notwithstanding the limited prejudice caused to the cancellation applicant by the delay in the proceedings and cognizant of the impact of my decision on the related proceedings between the parties, I decline to exercise the discretion available to me under rule 38(6). The tribunal discharged its responsibilities in sending a letter serving the Form TM26(N) on YETIGEL at the correct address for service for which a signature was obtained. While I appreciate that the relevant person or people may not have had sight of the tribunal's serving letter, the fact remains that it was posted via

a tracked delivery method, the sole purpose of which was to follow the mail item's journey to its destination and be satisfied of its delivery. That is the case here, and the loss of a trade mark registration is the unfortunate consequence of a failure to comply with the non-extensible Form TM8(N) deadline.

## **CONCLUSION**

51. I have found that rule 76 does not apply. Rule 77(5) is not invoked. I decline to exercise the discretion available to me under rule 38(6).

52. Subject to any successful appeal, YETIGEL INTERNATIONAL (S.A) will be treated as not opposing the application for revocation and the registration will be revoked in full under sections 46(1)(a) and 46(1)(b) of the Act with effect from the earliest date sought, i.e. 6 August 2021.

## **COSTS**

53. As my decision terminates the proceedings, I must consider the matter of costs. As the cancellation applicant has been successful, it is entitled to a contribution towards its costs. Awards of costs in proceedings are governed by Annex A of Tribunal Practice Notice ("TPN") 2/2016. The cancellation applicant, in its written submissions dated 5 April 2022, has requested that the tribunal award costs off the scale:

"24. The Applicant for Revocation requests that costs be awarded off the scale, and in recognition of the additional expense to which the Applicant for Revocation has been put as a result of the Registrant's ongoing attempt to late-file the TM8(N), including the evidence the Applicant for Revocation has been forced to review and consider, and the costs incurred in preparing and filing the present submissions."

54. TPN 2/2000 recognises that it is vital that the Registry has the ability to award costs off the scale, approaching full compensation, to deal

proportionately with wider breaches of rules, delaying tactics or other unreasonable behaviour. TPN 4/2007 provides further guidance and states:

“5. [...] Whilst TPN 2/2000 provides some examples of unreasonable behaviour, which would lead to an off scale award of costs, it acknowledges that it would be impossible to indicate all the circumstances in which a Hearing Officer could or should depart from the published scale of costs. The overriding factor was and remains that the Hearing Officer should act judicially in all the facts of a case. It is worth clarifying that just because a party has lost, this in itself is not indicative of unreasonable behaviour.

[...]

7. Any claim for cost approaching full compensation or for “extra costs” will need to be supported by a bill itemising the actual costs incurred.”

55. While YETIGEL filed its Form TM8(N) out of time and I have concluded that the reasons are not sufficient to apply rule 76 or rule 77(5), nor for me to exercise my discretion to admit the late filed Form TM8(N) into these proceedings, I am not satisfied that YETIGEL’s behaviour constitutes a breach of the rules, delaying tactics or is sufficiently unreasonable to justify awarding costs off the standard scale. Further, the cancellation applicant’s request for costs off the scale has not been supported by a bill itemising the actual costs incurred. I decline to make an award of costs off the scale. I will, however, take into account the tasks required of the cancellation applicant as a result of the YETIGEL’s late-filing of its Form TM8(N) that would otherwise not have been necessary. Consequently, I award costs to the cancellation applicant on the following basis:

Preparation of the application: £200

Considering and commenting on the other side's evidence:	£750
Preparation of written submissions in lieu of attending hearing:	£400
Official fees:	£200
<b>Total:</b>	<b>£1550</b>

56. I order YETIGEL INTERNATIONAL (S.A) to pay YETI Coolers, LLC £1550. This sum is to be paid within twenty-one days of the expiry of the appeal period or within twenty-one days of the final determination of this case if any appeal against this decision is unsuccessful.
